Elections for the Council are held every 4 years. Keynsham Town Councillors do not receive any remuneration but give their time, services and skills freely for the benefit of the community.

By becoming a Town Councillor you can make a difference to the quality of other people's daily lives and prospects.

The role and responsibility of a councillor includes representing the ward for which they are elected: decision-making and developing and reviewing council policies.

WHO CAN BE A COUNCILLOR?

- The easy answer is almost anyone as long as you are:
- At least 18 years old on the day of your nomination
 - A British Citizen, a citizen of another member state of the European Union or an eligible citizen of a Commonwealth country
 - Either on the electoral role of Bath & North East Somerset Council, or have lived and worked in the area for at least the last 12 months.

N.B. Other Criteria does apply.
