WESTlocal services have been funded by DfT BSIP funding, and we are awaiting an announcement from the DfT regarding our Bus Grant (formally BSIP) funding for 2026/27. We have been told it will be announced in the coming weeks.

In the meantime, we are evaluating all the BSIP/Bus Grant funded bus services and initiatives further. To do this, we need as much data as possible and I will send you another email to request this.

The date in January which may have been referred to, is the start of 70-day bus registration period ahead of the April 2025 service change date.
