### 8. <u>DRAFT NDP DOCUMENT (Recreation Topic Group Matrices and draft Policy Statements attached)</u>

The first item to look at is the Health and Wellbeing — Recreation Policy (looking at how doctor's surgeries work now compared to when the plan was started.
