RESOLVED:

d) *To note that all of the drop in NDP Residents' consultation help sessions have now been completed. However, a further stall has been booked at the Farmers Market on Saturday 10th August 2024 and Councillors are asked to help if able to. The staff will also do regular sessions giving out QR codes and consultation documents outside the Library over the next few weeks.*
